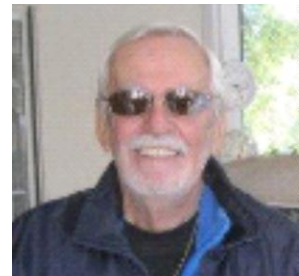

He was a ship's captain in later life, possessing Multi-ton and Tug captain's licensing. Wayne operated Cruise Vessels in the waters of the State of Maine and was a long time member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary. Upon relocating to Florida, he was a substitute Captain to the local Dinner Cruise Ships.
